A trained counsellor and professional photographer with a passion for helping people reveal their stories and experiences of life.



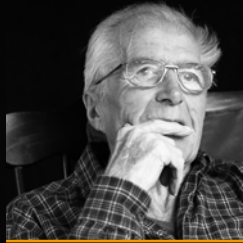
### **Justin Bevan**

An independent film maker and voiceover artist, driven by a desire to preserve the stories of our own personal heroes.

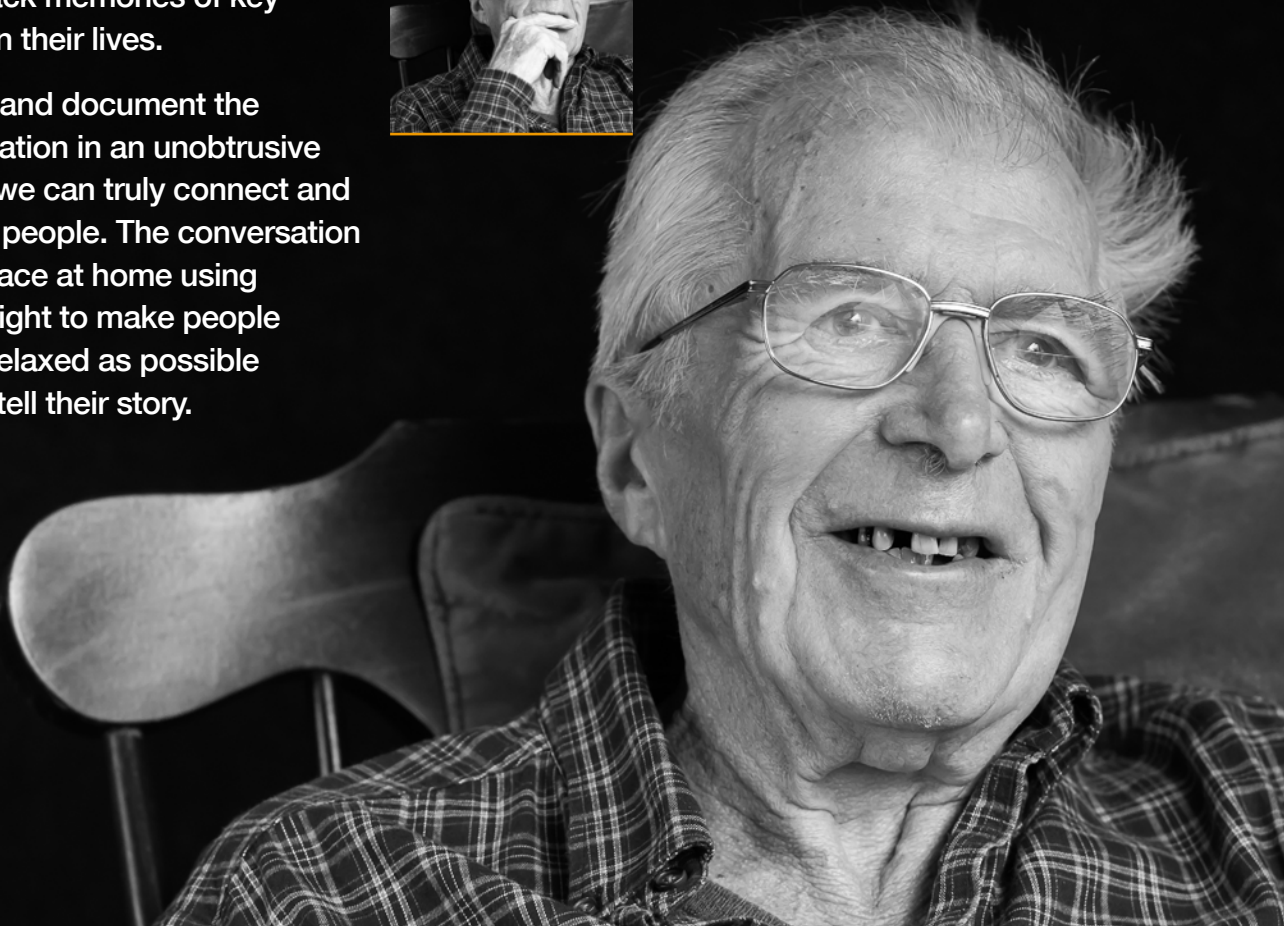
## How we do it

We help people to reveal their true personality through a process we call 'conversational photography'. We use listening skills to create a safe, engaging and respectful environment where people can talk about their life experience and help them to reminisce and bring back memories of key events in their lives.

We film and document the conversation in an unobtrusive way so we can truly connect and witness people. The conversation takes place at home using natural light to make people feel as relaxed as possible as they tell their story.
